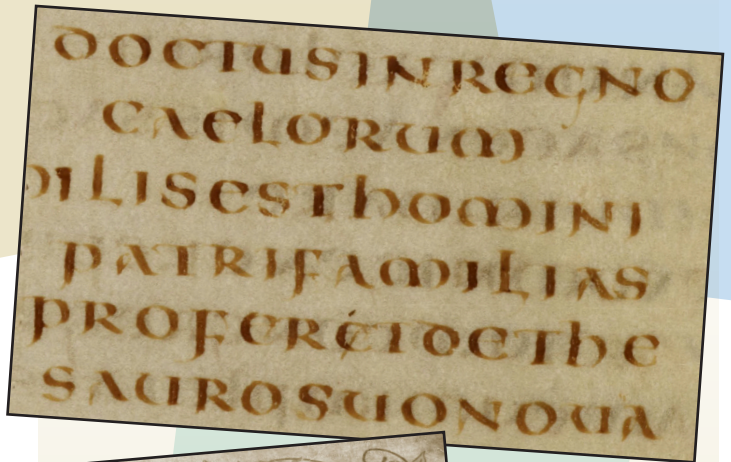

New Letters From Old:

Taking Latin Uncials (from the Four Gospels in Latin, VI Century, BL Harley Ms. 1775) as our reference point, and also looking at some other historical variations and derivations, this workshop explores bringing Uncial forms up to date, refining and redesigning them to either compliment formal calligraphic compositions or to use on their own.

In this one-day class you will learn how to write with a traditional dip pen, using lightness and pressure to create beautiful thin and thick strokes. We will cover pen "pressure and release" techniques along with the basics of decorating letters.

At the end of the workshop you will take home example alphabets, so you can continue to enjoy modern Uncials.



Materials to Bring:

- Please bring your usual calligraphic kit
- Layout paper for practice and a good HP-paper for finished work if time allows
- Ruler 50cm, thin automatic pencil
- Japanese calligraphy ink stick and ink stone (if you have)
- Penholder and some writing nibs
- Set of watercolours or gouache, water container, mixing brush
- Some materials will be available for purchase during the course.

- Something you enjoy to write: a piece of poetry or prose.
